



15 Nights / 16 Days Heritage Tour of North India



This tour explores the richness of the most historic of Northern India's fabulous historic sites. From Delhi to the Golden Fort of Jaisalmer, to Jodhpur and Udaipur where the palace floats on a magical lake, Pushkar and the Amber Fort at Jaipur and the unmissable Taj Mahal.

DAY 01: Arrival Delhi. Welcome and transfer to your hotel for overnight stay.

DAY 02: Delhi - Mandawa (6h 270 Km). Drive to Mandawa, famous for its fresco painted havelis, its castles, forts, temples and colourful culture.

DAY 03: Mandawa – Bikaner (3½ h 180 Km). Drive to Bikaner, one of the oldest cities in Rajasthan. Visit the Fort of Junagarh, the Red Palace, camel breeding farm and the world famous Rats Temple.

Day 04: Bikaner - Jaisalmer (6h 325 Km). Drive to Jaisalmer, known as "The Golden City". This city has faced many invasions of Muslim emperors but still its culture and traditions are unchanged.

DAY 05 : Jaisalmer. Visit the Golden Fort, Gadi Sagar Lake, Ludharva, the old Capital of Jaisalmer or Kuldehra, an abandoned city. Take a camel ride in the sand dunes of Khuri or Sam.

DAY 06: Jaisalmer - Jodhpur (5h 280Km). Drive to Jodhpur, visit the hilltop fortress of Mehrangarh , Ummaid bhavan Museum and Palace, Mandore old capital, or shop at the busy Clocktower Markets.

Day 07 : Jodhpur - Ranakpur (3h 130 Km). After breakfast drive to Ranakpur. Ranakpur has one of the biggest and beautiful Jain temples in India.

DAY 08: Rankpur - Udaipur (2h 90Km). After breakfast drive to Udaipur, "The Venice of East", the most romantic city in India bounded by the remains of the city wall on the east side of Lake Pichola.

DAY 09 : Udaipur. Visit some of the many ancient sties in the city. At the Bagore-ki-Haveli see the traditonal dance of Rajasthan. (starts at 19 hrs)

DAY 10: Udaipur - Chittorgarh (2½ h 120 Km). Drive to Chittorgarh, the oldest city of Rajasthan. Spread over 21 sq Km, the hill-top fortress is one of the most massive and historically significant in Rajasthan.

DAY 11: Chittorgarh - Pushkar (4h 200 Km). Pushkar is a very important place of pilgrimage for Hindus and famous for its Pushkar fair which takes place in November.

DAY 12: Pushkar - Jaipur (4h 150 kms). After a walking tour of the painted 'havelis' of some of the leading business families of the country drive to Jaipur - the fabled "pink city" of the desert named after Jai Singh, the former Maharaja of Jaipur.

DAY 13 : Jaipur. Take an excursion to the Amber Fort on the outskirts of Jaipur, arriving on the back of an elephant. Later go on a sightseeing tour of Jaipur, visit a rug or a gem factory.

DAY 14: Jaipur - Agra (5h 232kms). Drive to Agra. Enroute visit the abandoned city of Fatehpur Sikri constructed by Akbar The Great in the 15th century.

DAY 15 : Agra – Delhi (5h 250 Km) After breakfast visit the magnificent Taj Mahal -one of the seven wonders of the world and surely the most extravagant expression of love ever created. Drive to Delhi. Evening free to explore the Delhi Local Market.

DAY 16: Delhi - Transfer to airport for onward flight.
